APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Scholarship Amounts Awarded

There will be three scholarships awarded, totaling \$10,000 given.

- ONE recipient will be awarded \$5,000
- TWO recipients will be awarded \$2,500

Scholarship Requirements:

- Applicant must be currently enrolled in college and have completed at least one semester in college
- Applicants enrolled in Vocational and out of state schools will be accepted.
- Applicant must be a member, or have at least one parent/guardian who is a member, of the Montana Stockgrowers Association
- Applicant must demonstrate a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0

Materials Required:

- A 500-word essay discussing educational pursuits, potential impact of chosen field and why the applicant feels they are deserving of the scholarship funds.
- Two letters of recommendation:
 - A letter addressing your academic accomplishments
 - A letter addressing your activities in the cattle industry
- Copy of transcript (*non-official transcripts are accepted*)

Additional Requirements of Scholarship Recipients

- All scholarship recipients will be required to attend an MSGA event. MSF will pay for all expenses to the event the recipient will attend.
- A letter from the College stating the student is currently enrolled will be required.
- Recipients will be required to submit a follow-up letter or an in person visit or Zoom meeting with the MSF Trustees one year after receiving scholarship funds.
- Finalists will be required to attend an in-person interview with the selection committee. The in-person interviews will take place in Billings.
